To make your own template:

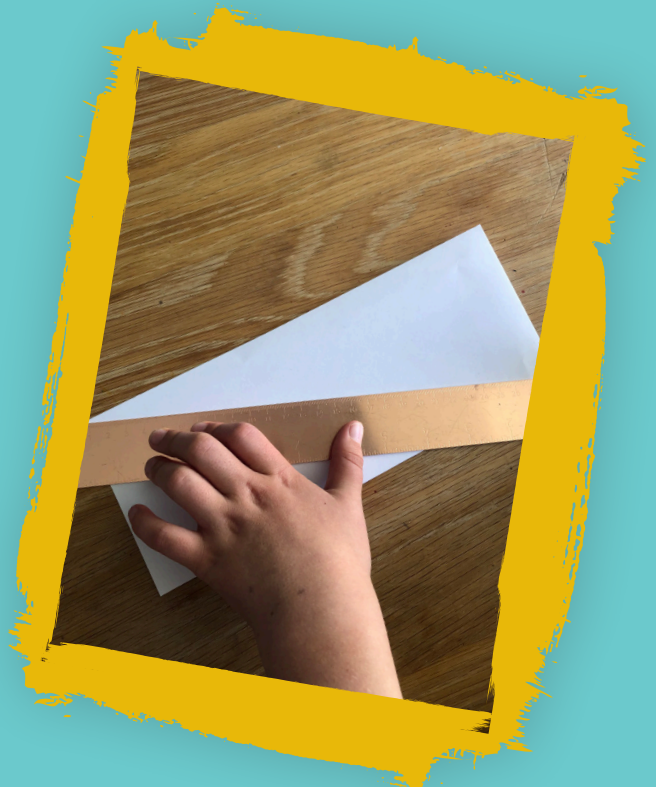


Take an A4 piece of paper  
Fold over about 2cm at the top  
(on the shorter side)

Fold the paper in  
half lengthways



Draw a diagonal  
line from the  
outside of the  
paper, starting at  
the top of the fold,  
to the middle at  
the bottom



Cut along the line  
(through both  
sides of the paper)



Unfold the  
paper



Decorate the main triangle.  
Leave the top strip blank.



You can decorate your flag with anything you like.  
If you get stuck, some ideas for drawings are:

A WW2 soldier

A land girl

A Thank You  
message

A relative who was / is in  
the armed forces

Union Flag

Or, download our colouring in templates.

# Make your Bunting



When all of your triangles are decorated, fold the flap at the top over some string or ribbon and glue or tape in place



Leave a gap between each flag  
and keep adding until you're done.  
Leave some spare string or ribbon at  
each end for hanging



Hang your bunting in your window  
for people to enjoy!
